Meeting minutes: Meeting minutes were read and approved

Guest Remarks from Mrs Hui:

First day of new lunch procedure. All children get grab and go breakfast. K-2 received cold lunch, 3-5 received hot lunch. Kids were trained on how to carry their hot lunch without dropping the milk and fruit.

Guest Remarks from Principal Kelly:

The lunch is in one location in school. There are 600 children who need to receive food in less than 2 hours with social distancing. The school is starting with 3-5 since they were eating lunch in the cafeteria when they were in school before the pandemic. The lower grades have not had the experience. Therefore, they need to be trained. Survey showed that most parents preferred lunch in the classroom and second was lunch. Eventually everyone will receive hot lunch in the classroom. On Monday 2nd grade will start the training to carry their lunch. 1st grade will be able to carry their trays however, kindergarten might be hard.

Parents suggestion: Would it be possible to have plastic trays in the cafeteria. Mrs. Kelly will check about this.

Superhero day combined with kindness was announced.

Guest Remarks from Ms Bryant: School social worker for PS174, 14 year experience in child welfare, Ms Bryant is LCSW. She works on academic, emotional and social support to the children. Presentation on Transitioning students back to school after the pandemic. Children have been impacted by the life changes as a result of the pandemic. Children need emotional support when they are overwhelmed by their home environment. Tips for parents: Re-establish morning and bedtime routines/schedule, ensure they have breakfast at home or in school, routine physical exams, ask students how their day has been, ask what happened at school to help make connection between home and school, practice with your child how to ask for help and assistance, encourage them to ask for help and support, parents are encouraged to ask for help and support from school, encourage good study habits such as review, reading together in the lower grade, upper grade children should be encouraged to talk about what they are reading to encourage reading comprehension, ensure child has clear and designated work space,

remind your child of their strengths because they are going to need them to grow, help them find their strength. Social and emotional health is a key to academic success.
