  - a. Ms. Bryant discussed the importance of Student Voice, Student Ideas
  - b. Introduction of Student Representatives
  - c. Representatives include students from ICT, ELL, G&T, Self-Contained
  - d. Hoping to expand K-1 Lunch/recess program to other grades
  - e. How to make recess more fun, ideas include swings, rock climbing wall, monkey bars
  - f. Seeking parents' support and principal permission for monthly snack sale days
  - g. Post welcome signs at the entrance of the school auditorium in different languages
  - h. Indoor activities for the classrooms and gyms during indoor recess periods (volleyball etc)
  - i. Planting program, seeds and equipment provided by students, could be a fundraiser
  - j. Diversity- clubs that are more diverse (such as taekwondo)
  - k. Trying to meet monthly, but recently have been meeting every other week to prepare and understand roles

  - Dr. Lewis is on board with these ideas and working on logistics
- c. Parent Question- recess time
  - i. Kids and parents are both requesting it, it has improved but what are the roadblocks, can parents help or volunteer?
  - ii. Ms. Bryant- weather permitting they can go outside unless they are on the rotational schedule. Teachers can sign up to take their classes out for additional periods. There is a parent sign up for lunch volunteers and Ms. Bryant is holding a workshop to help parents know what to expect and what is expected of them. Ms. Bryant will be in communication about this.
